CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. These Conditions of Entry apply to the New South Wales Paint Horse Association (NSWPHA) State Championships held at Dubbo Showground on Tuesday 7th November 2023 to Saturday 11th November 2023 hereinafter referred to as the "State Show".
2. 2 Year Old Ridden Horses may not compete at the State Show
3. The State Show will be conducted with a combination of the Rules of (dependent on event) the Paint Horse Association of Australia (PHAA), Australian Quarter Horse Association and the Rules of the Horse Show Association of Australia (HSAA). Note: NSWPHA will allow multiple rider horse combinations but only one combination per event.
4. All decisions affecting or concerning the conduct of the State Show shall be made by a Show Committee consisting of such Office Bearers and Committee Members of the NSWPHA as shall be present at such times and at such places as shall be notified by the President of the NSWPHA. The Show Committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes where there are fewer than four Entries competing.
5. Refunds of entry fees can be applied for by filling out an official refund form which is available on the website or at the show office and submitted to the show secretary. Refunds must be in writing and lodged no less than 24 hours prior to the commencement of that Event. Requests will not be granted unless accompanied by a certificate from a Veterinary Surgeon attesting that the horse in respect of which the refund is sought has either died or is unfit to compete due to injury or disease.
6. Each horse nominated for an Event at the Show must be registered with the Paint Horses Association of Australia. All registered Paint Bred horses may only compete in Halter classes nominated for 'Paint Bred'. All other performance classes are open to Paint Bred and Regular Registered horses.
7. All Owners and Handlers or Riders of all Paint Horses competing in the State Show must be members of the PHAA. The entry of each person nominated as a handler/rider for any Event will not be accepted until such times as a copy of that person's 2023/24 PHAA Membership Card and if applicable Amateur Owner Card or other documentary proof of current PHAA Membership and Amateur Owner status is lodged with the Show Secretary. Such proof must be supplied prior to the event.
8. It is the intention of the NSWPHA that each horse shall perform at the State Show on its merits without the aid of drugs which may affect the conduct, appearance or performance of the horse. The Show Committee may make or cause to be made on any horse which competes in any Event at the Show such tests as are necessary to determine whether any prohibited drug has been administered to that horse. A prohibited drug is a substance originating externally whether endogenous to the horse or not which may affect the appearance, performance, conduct or behaviour of a horse by its action upon the central nervous system, the peripheral nervous system, the cardiovascular system, the respiratory system, the alimentary digestive system, the musculoskeletal system or the urogenital system and shall include substances within the pharmacological categories of analgesics, anti-histamines, anti-inflammatory agents, blood coagulants, diuretics, hormones and their synthetic counter parts, cortico-steroids, anabolic steroids, local anesthetics, muscle relaxants, stimulants and tranquillisers.
9. The owner of a horse or the person for the time being responsible for a horse at the State Show shall permit any person authorized by the Show Committee to collect samples of blood and/or urine from that horse for the purposes of making the tests referred to in Condition 7. Failure to make the horse available for testing or failure to permit the collection of samples from the horse or a finding that a prohibited drug has been administered to the horse will attract such penalty, including prior or post disqualification of the horse from any Event in which it has been entered at the Show and the forfeiture of any prizes or awards made to the horse's owners, riders and/or handlers in respect of any Event in which the horse has competed at the Show, as may be decided by the Show Committee in accordance with PHAA Rules. Veterinary Certificates must be supplied to the show office prior to commencement of show. If a horse tests positive to a banned substance and a Veterinary certificate has not been supplied, the owner/competitor will be liable for all costs associated with the testing.
10. Each competitor in an Event shall be present in or immediately adjacent to the designated Marshalling Area no later than five minutes prior to the commencement of that Event and shall signify his/her presence upon request of the Marshalling Steward. The commencement of an Event will not be delayed solely because an entrant in it has not yet signified his/her presence to the Marshalling Steward.
11. No competitor in an Event shall enter the arena to participate in that Event except on direction of the Gate Steward.
12. The Gate Steward may prevent entry to the arena for an Event of any entrant whose attire, equipment, behaviour or degree of control over his/her horse is not in the opinion of the Gate Steward appropriate to that Event or whose horse is in the opinion of the Gate Steward exhibiting lameness or any injury or other degree of fitness of purpose which may render it unsuitable for competition in the Event.
13. Upon entry to the arena for an Event a competitor becomes and remains under the control and direction of the judge until such time as the judge signifies that the competitor is dismissed from the arena.
14. All protests are to be in writing and are to be lodged with the Show Secretary no later than one hour after completion of the class for a fee of \$50. Protests are to conform with and be dealt with in accordance with AQHA Rules. If upheld, protest fees will be refunded.
15. All competitors are required to comply with Dubbo Council conditions use of stabling, camping areas and other ground facilities as specified by the Dubbo Council management. It is mandatory that all Owners, handlers and riders be current financial members of the NSWPHA.

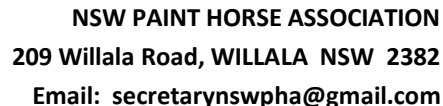
